

This year...

- There are more than 420,000 school age students with intellectual disability in the United States¹
- Fewer than 2% are likely to attend college after high school

For the 98% of adults with intellectual disability who don't go to college - the current reality

- Only 15% have paid employment in the community²
- 42% attend a day program or sheltered workshop²
- 44% report they often or sometimes feel lonely²
- 29.3% live below the poverty line³

For the 2% who attend postsecondary education, the outcomes are promising...

- 59% find competitive, integrated employment
 1 year after exit⁴
- 87% of students were enrolled in a credential program^{4*}
- 100% of programs provided peer mentor support to students^{4*}
