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Program Description

- Academy lives in a Department that is housed in a College within the University
- Students apply to the University to participate in the Academy
- If admitted, they enter a program and take courses that lead to program completion
- The fees? Regular University tuition and fees
- If that sounds like “*going to college*”...

Program Description

- Post Secondary Certificate programs
- First Academy Admission: January 2016
- Three Cohorts: 9-15 admitted per cohort
- Start-up funding through private foundation (for faculty, job coaches, & peer mentors)
- First Academy Graduate: December 2017

Curriculum Design

Three Certificate Programs

- **Supported Employment**
- **Supported Community Access**
- **Supported Community Living**

Supported Employment Certificate is Required for Everybody

Coursework

- Each certificate is approximately 20 credits
- Combination of specialized ACI courses & other courses from FAU catalog
- Some electives are available
- Some audit options exist
- Most ACI courses = 2 credits
- Most ACI courses designed under UDL principles
